Fees

The fees for each course are €400 and cover tuition, course materials, accommodation and meals. Single rooms are available on payment of a supplement.

A deposit of €200 is payable on registration and the balance of fees one month before the course begins.

An Cúrsa

The Course is sanctioned by the Department of Education and Science and covers all aspects of the SCG examinations. Qualified experienced teachers will provide sample essay material while also emphasising the production of unique material. Particular importance will be placed on style, in terms of prose and poetry answers.

A scrúdú cainte examination will be offered to each course participant, with subsequent feedback and analysis. Time will also be devoted to methodologies in a theoretical fashion and in a practical manner.

Every effort is made to ensure that Irish is developed in a normal and relaxed atmosphere. Morning classes are beneficial for written, oral and aural examinations. Special emphasis is placed on integrating the oral and aural work throughout the course. Afternoon and evening sessions will encourage participants to involve themselves in activities that are sport, music, information technology and art based. Learning will occur through encouragement, total immersion and involvement. Teachers on the course are familiar with the SCG examinations and syllabus content.
